

General Information for Club Activities & Events Including on Snow

Huntly Nordic and Outdoor Centre / The Clashindarroch Forest

- Clubs and groups can hold organised meets for up to 30 people (adults and children, including organisers and coaches) from any number of households (with 2m physical distancing) however we would advise keeping groups small around 6 – 8 people to ensure they are easier to manage.
- All must Register & be marked in attendance for the event to meet our obligation to Test and Protect (Our current booking system will cope with this)
- When arriving to Activity “bubble” the participants should comply with general Covid guidance
- As participants arrive at the field of play we would like them to sanitise their hands
- Participants should have a face mask with them (they should not need the face mask to ski but there may be reasons for its use such as at a briefing by an organiser/coach)
- We would suggest all participants sanitise their hands on departure
- As soon as a participant has completed training, a competition or event, they should leave the field of play/venue.
- In general the field of play at the Clashindarroch is assumed to be forest gate next to the car park. Any particular club event may change the definition of the field of play for particular reasons, which will be identified to participants
- In general the field of play at the Ski Centre is assumed to be the car gate next to the car park. Any particular club event may change the definition of the field of play for particular reasons, which will be identified to participants
- No spectating should take place other than where a parent or carer is supervising a child or vulnerable adult (Where an adult is supervising they count as being part of the bubble of 30)
- The “Hytte” in the forest may act as an organisational point but please note it only has room for 2 people to meet Covid guidance
- The forest toilets near the Hytte are not maintained by HNSC, and should only be used with good hygiene (please sanitise hands before and after use)
- The toilets at the ski centre are maintained and operated by the ski centre. The ski centre has it’s own Covid guidelines which includes obtaining permission to use the toilets, wearing a mask when inside & sanitising hands before and after having been in the building. The Centre will also keep a list of people coming into the building for Test and Protect
- The Club will only hold records of participation for a month for Test and Protect purposes – no personal information will be shared by the club for any other reason.

All bookable events/ activities run by the club are considered “Organised Sport or Physical Activity” within the current (15/12/20) Sport Scotland Guidelines therefore there are travel restrictions as shown here:
